Family Restrooms

Accessible family restrooms are located near Park Base, at Walkabout Australia, and near Mawazo Kitchen.

Guests with Disabilities

Information is available at Safari ticket booths and Park Base. The elevator system and our Nature Trail provides access to attractions at lower elevations, including Africa Tram, Lion Camp, and African Outpost.

ADA shuttles are available for guests with mobility needs. Shuttles run continuously. There may be a 20-minute wait between shuttle arrivals.

Lockers

Large and small rental lockers are available on a first come, first served basis, just inside the Park entrance.

Information, First Aid, Lost & Found, and inquiries regarding public transit and plant identification.

Rentals

Strollers, wheelchairs, and motorized mobility scooters are available for rent on a first come, first served basis at Safari Outfitters, just inside the Park Entrance.

Safety

Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times.

Conservation

The Safari Park recycles and reclaims the water used in restrooms, streams, fountains, play elements, and animal habitat pools.

You can conserve water at home by:

- Planting drought-resistant lawns and shrubs.
- Making sure your home is leak-free.
- Installing high-efficiency plumbing fixtures.

Protect the environment by allowing plants to grow and by disposing of recyclables and trash in appropriate containers.
